Circa 1880s Victorian ring features a silver topped 14K yellow gold navette shaped setting accented with twenty-seven (27), prong set, old mine cut diamonds. The silver topped 14K yellow gold shoulders are each accented with three (3), channel set, old mine cut diamonds. The ring measures 22.3mm at the top, rises 6.4mm above the finger, tapering to 1.4mm wide and 1.2mm thick at the base of the shank.
