Circa late-Victorian ring features a fourteen karat yellow gold ornate plaque with a pierced design and scroll motifs. The ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond set into an eight-prong buttercup style head. The ring is finished with a ten karat yellow gold shank with a carved floral design at the shoulders. The ring measures 35.8mm at the top, rises 6.5mm above the finger, tapering to 1.8mm wide and 0.7mm thick at the base of the shank.



