(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) round transitional brilliant cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The top of the shoulders are each accented with three (3), bead set, round single cut diamonds. The top and side faces of the shank feature engraved detail and bordered with milgrain edging. The ring measures 7.2mm at the top, rises 6.7mm above the finger, tapering to 1.5mm wide and 0.7mm thick at the base of the shank.


