(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) round transitional brilliant cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The pierced gallery is accented with twelve (12), bead set, round single cut diamonds, bordered with milgrain edging. Engraved wheat and floral motifs accented the top half of the shank. The ring measures 10.9mm at the top, rises 6.0mm above the finger, tapering to 2.1mm wide and 1.0mm thick at the base of the shank.
