(1) Ladies 14K Two Tone Gold Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond set into a white gold four-prong head. Engraved white gold details, bordered with milgrain edging accented the top of each shoulder. The ring is finshed with a yellow gold tapered shank. The ring measures 4.9mm at the top, rises 4.5mm above the finger, tapering to 1.5mm wide and 1.0mm thick at the base of the shank.
