The ring measures 7.0mm at the top, rises 7.1mm above the finger, tapering to 1.1mm wide and 1.1mm thick at the base of the shank.

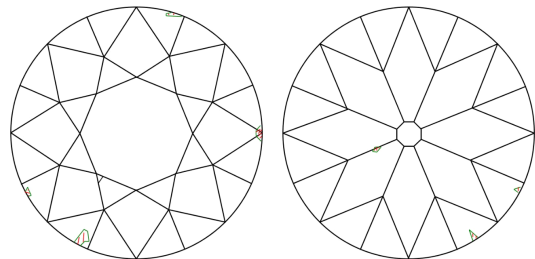
