(1) Ladies 14K White Gold Diamond Ring

Circa 1950s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond weighing 0.72 carat and set into a four-prong head. The shoulders of the ring are each accented with three (3), channel set, round single cut diamonds. The ring measures 5.4mm at the top, rises 7.0mm above the finger, tapering to 2.4mm wide and 1.6mm thick at the base of the shank.


