(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond weighing 2.60 carats and set into a four-prong head. The top face of the shank is accented with a row of three (3), bead set, round single cut diamonds on each side. The ring measures 7.9mm at the top, rises 6.6mm above the finger, tapering to 1.6mm wide and 0.8mm thick at the base of the shank.
