(1) Ladies 18K White Gold Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring features a pierced design with milgrain edging and engraved floral motifs. The side faces of the gallery are broken on each side. The ring contains one (1) round transitional brilliant cut diamond weighing 0.28 carat that is set into a bezel. The ring measures 9.3mm at the top, rises 5.5mm above the finger, tapering to 1.5mm wide and 1.3mm thick at the base of the shank.
