# (1) Ladies 14K Yellow Gold Diamond Ring

Circa late Victorian snake ring is topped with one (1), prong set, old mine cut diamond. The snakes wraps around the finger and is accented with engraved snake scales. The ring measures 11.3mm at the top, rises 4.4mm above the finger, tapering to 3.4mm wide and 0.9mm thick at the base of the shank.
