Circa 1890s ring is contains one (1) old European cut diamond set into a platinum eight-prong head. The shoulders are topped with platinum engraved plaques with a pierced design and bordered with milgrain edging. The ring is finished with an eighteen karat yellow gold shank. The ring measures 7.8mm at the top, rises 6.6mm above the finger, tapering to 1.3mm wide and 0.8mm thick at the base of the shank.

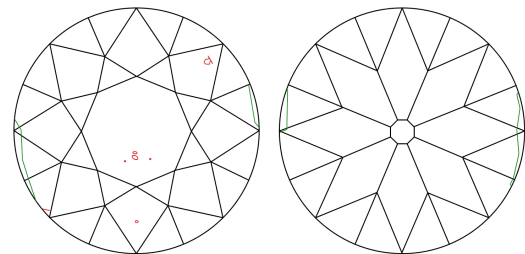
