(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) round transitional brilliant cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The tiered gallery is accented with eighteen (18), bead set, round single cut diamonds, bordered with milgrain edging. The top and sides of the shank feature engraved wheat and scroll motifs. The ring measures 10.3mm at the top, rises 6.1mm above the finger, tapering to 1.8mm wide and 1.5mm thick at the base of the shank.


