Circa 1922 solitaire engagement ring contains one (1) old mine cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The shank is accented with engraved floral motifs. The ring measures 6.2mm at the top, rises 6.1mm above the finger, tapering to 1.9mm wide and 1.0mm thick at the base of the shank. The inside shank is engraved with initials and the date Oct. 15 - 22.

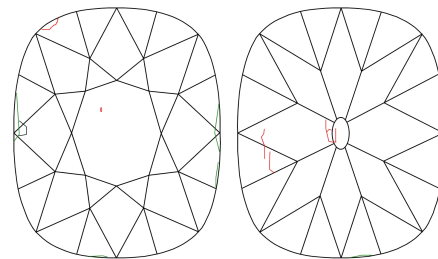
