(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1920s ring is centered with one (1) old European cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The shoulders of the ring features a pierced design and are each accented with one (1), bezel set, marquise brilliant cut diamond and three (3), bead set, round single cut diamonds. The ring measures 8.7mm at the top, rises 4.8mm above the finger, tapering to 1.5mm wide and 0.8mm thick at the base of the shank.
