(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond set into a four-prong head. The shoulders of the ring feature a pierced design and is accented with one (1), bead set, round single cut diamonds, bordered with milgrain edging. The ring measures 7.2mm at the top, rises 4.2mm above the finger, tapering to 1.4mm wide and 0.8mm thick at the base of the shank.
