Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old European cut diamond set into a four-prong fishtail style head. The top of the shank is accented with one (1), bead set, round transitional brilliant cut diamond and three (3), bead set, round single cut diamonds. The ring measures 10.2mm at the top, rises 8.1mm above the finger, tapering to 1.3mm wide and 1.0mm thick at the base of the shank.

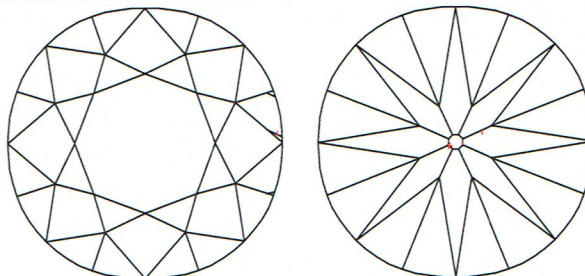
