(1) Ladies Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1920s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond weighing 1.66 carats and set into a four-prong setting. The shoulders of the ring feature a pierced design and is accented with twelve (12), bead set, round single cut diamonds on each side. The ring measures 6.9mm at the top, rises 5.2mm above the finger, tapering to 1.0mm wide and 0.8mm thick at the base of the shank.


