Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond weighing 2.53 carats and set into a four-prong setting. Engraved details accent the top and side faces of the shank. The shoulders of the ring are each accented with nine (9), bead set, round single cut diamonds. The side faces of the ring are each accented with six (6) round single cut diamonds bead set into a heart shaped settings. The ring measures 8.5mm at the top, rises 7.4mm above the finger, tapering to 1.6mm wide and 1.2mm thick at the base of the shank.
