(1) Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1930s ring is centered with one (1) old European cut diamond weighing 1.28 carats that is set into a four-prong setting. The gallery is bordered with milgrain edging and accented with twenty (20), bead set, round single cut diamonds and four (4), calibre' French cut green glass. Engraved details accent the top half of the shank. The ring measures 14.1mm at the top, rises 5.5mm above the finger, tapering to 1.7mm wide and 1.1mm thick at the base of the shank.
