(1) Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1920s ring features a pierced design with engraved details and bordered with milgrain edging. The ring is centered with one (1) old European cut diamond weighing 0.91 carat that is set into a four-split prong setting. The ring is also accented with six (6), bead set, old European/single cut diamonds and four (4), channel set, square French cut synthetic blue sapphires. The ring measures 10.5mm at the top, rises 6.8mm above the finger, tapering to 1.7mm wide and 1.2mm thick at the base of the shank.

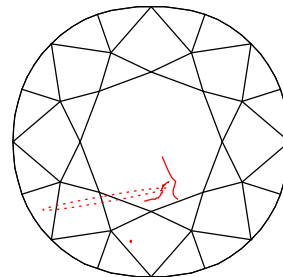
