The ring measures 6.6mm at the top, rises 5.1mm above the finger, tapering to 1.5mm wide and 1.3mm thick at the base of the shank.

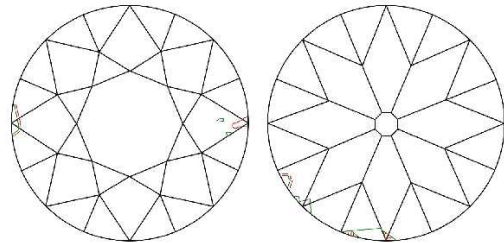
