Circa 1940s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond weighing 1.11 carats and set into a four-prong fishtail style setting. The shoulders of the ring are each accented with three (3), prong set, old European/round transitional brilliant cut diamonds. The ring measures 7.0mm at the top, rises 7.6mm above the finger, tapering to 1.8mm wide and 1.5mm thick at the base of the shank.

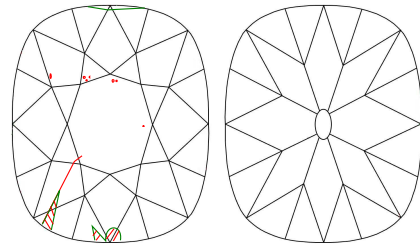
