Circa 1920s solitaire ring contains one (1) round transitional brilliant cut diamond weighing 1.59 carats and set into a white gold six-prong head. The ring measures 8.1mm at the top, rises 8.9mm above the finger, tapering to 1.6mm wide and 0.9mm thick at the base of the shank.

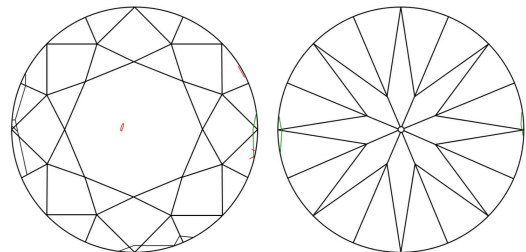
