(1) Platinum Diamond Ring

Circa 1920s ring is centered with one (1) old mine cut diamond set into a four-split prong setting. The shoulders of the ring are each accented with one (1) bezel set antique marquise brilliant cut diamond and one (1) semi-bezel set round transitional brilliant cut diamonds. The ring measures 7.9mm at the top, rises 7.1mm above the finger, tapering to 2.0mm wide and 1.1mm thick at the base of the shank.


